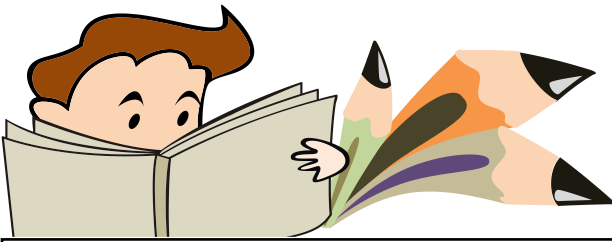

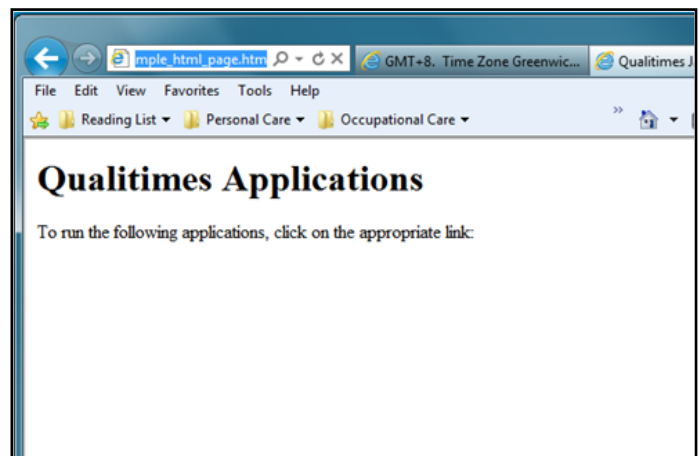
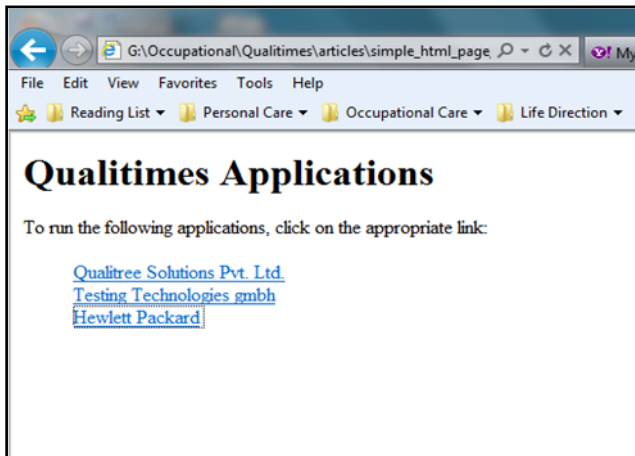


Glimpse at Java Web Applications - Part IV

A SHORT COURSE IN HTML

In a typical web application, Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) is used to provide the user interface. Then, the user can navigate through the HTML pages to view information, and also can enter data into HTML forms that pass that data to JavaServer Pages (JSPs) and servlets. That's why we need to have a basic set of HTML skills before we can code JSPs and servlets. So let's start by visiting some HTML basics and HTML forms fundamentals.

A simple HTML page or document consists of HTML "tags" which are keywords enclosed in "<" and ">" delimiters. These tags are interpreted by a HTML parser or interpreter which is part of a web browser. Do keep in mind that an HTML document is a collection or list of these HTML tags which define how the page will look when it is displayed by a web browser. Now, some of the HTML tags have a paired structure, i.e. both an opening and closing tag is required with data within treated as applicable content. Some other tags are not paired and are single requiring no closing tag. Please refer to the list below for most basic HTML tags we need to know.



<!doctype ... > Identifies the type of HTML doc.

<html> .. </html> Mark being and end of doc.

<head> .. </head> Start and end of Header.

<title> .. </title> Marks title displayed in Bar.

<body> .. </body> Start and end of body section.

 Inserts a line break.

...

<!-- ... --> Defines comments which are ignored.

Now HTML tags have certain properties associated with them known as "Attributes" which somewhat like adjectives and prepositions in language perform the task of modifying or constraining the behavior of HTML tags they are associated with. Links are very common and we see them as connectors between web pages. Links are specified in HTML using the anchor tag:

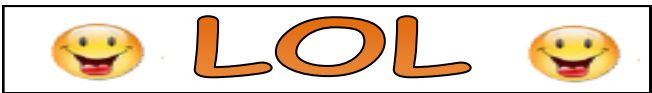
